HISTORY

The organization was founded by Ord. Prof. Mazhar Osman and his compatriots on March 5, 1920 in Istanbul under the name "Hilal-i Ahdar" to prevent occupation forces from disseminating alcohol and drugs in our country after the First World War and jeopardizing the spirit of resistance against the occupation.

The name "Hilal-i Ahdar" was later changed to "Green Crescent" and in 1934, under the Presidency of Mustafa Kemal Atatürk and the Prime Ministry of İsmet İnönü, the Green Crescent was granted the status of "Public Benefit Society" by a decision of the Council of Ministers.

Since its foundation, the Green Crescent's areas of work have diversified as the types of addiction have increased, and after alcohol, the activity area of the Green Crescent has expanded to cover tobacco, drugs, gambling and recently technology addiction.

VISION, MISSION

Vision

A Green Crescent that plays a leading role in tackling addiction at the national and international level.

Mission

The Green Crescent is a non-governmental organization with values based on human dignity and respect, working to protect society and youth from harmful habits without discrimination, tackling addictions such as tobacco, alcohol, drugs, technology, gambling, etc. by observing national and moral values and using scientific methods and carrying out preventive and rehabilitative public health and advocacy activities.

THE INDEPENDENCE INITIATIVE

The Independence Initiative is a nationwide movement led by Green Crescent in collaboration with the Ministry of Interior. It's designed to protect young people and societies as a whole from various forms of addiction, targeting issues like alcohol, tobacco, gambling, substance abuse, and internet overuse.

Awareness efforts will begin at the grassroots level in neighborhoods, expanding to schools where they engage students and teachers, local governments with decision-makers, and national policymakers. This holistic approach seeks to raise widespread awareness against the threat of addiction, reaching every corner of society and fostering a healthier, more independent future.







GREEN CRESCENT COUNSELING CENTER (YEDAM)

In 2013, Green Crescent amended its bylaws to adopt a holistic and multidimensional approach to addressing addiction, incorporating rehabilitation into its scope of work and leading to the establishment of the Green Crescent Counseling Center (YEDAM) in 2015. Green Crescent Counseling Center (YEDAM) provides free psychosocial support to individuals with alcohol, tobacco, drug, gambling, and internet addictions, as well as their households. Since 2021, it has been operating in all provinces of Türkiye and the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC).

GREEN CRESCENT REHABILITATION CENTER (REHAB)

In 2023, Green Crescent launched 40-bed rehabilitation centers in Diyarbakır and Bursa to address the physical, psychological, and social losses caused by addiction. These centers are dedicated to supporting individuals in reintegrating into society as healthy and independent members while also offering follow-up care after detoxification treatments. A third Green Crescent Rehabilitation Center is scheduled to open in Kayseri by 2025. These REHAB centers provide inpatient treatment for individuals diagnosed with alcohol and/or drug addiction who have completed a minimum 21-day detoxification process.

2024 DATA HIGHLIGHTS

In 2024, a total of 152 inpatient admissions were recorded. Fifty-six patients successfully completed their treatment and were discharged. Thirteen patients launched their professional careers in newly acquired professions, while nine were enrolled in distance education programs, allowing them to resume their studies. Additionally, twenty patients earned certifications in various fields, including Level 3 Welding (MYK), Butchery, Infographic Design, Culinary Assistance, Automotive Assembly, Basic Accounting, and Computer Operations.

GREEN CRESCENT ACADEMY

In response to both individual and organizational training needs, we offer seminars on topics such as alcohol, tobacco, substance, gambling, internet addiction and healthy living. Additionally, online courses are available through our learning management system and expert-led talks and discussions are organized.



GREEN CRESCENT ADDICTION PREVENTION TRAINING PROGRAM

Green Crescent Addiction Prevention Training Program aims to raise awareness and foster understanding across society, with a particular focus on children and young people. Offering evidence-based training tailored to different age groups, the program is designed to equip individuals with the necessary knowledge and skills to address issues related to alcohol, tobacco, substance, gambling, and internet addiction, as well as healthy living.





The training program is conducted in partnership with key institutions such as the Ministry of National Education, the Ministry of Youth and Sports, the Ministry of Health, the Ministry of National Defense, the Ministry of Family and Social Services, and numerous other organizations, reaching 10 million students and 3 million adults annually.

Participants can use the Learning Management System to access resources on alcohol, tobacco, substance, gambling, internet addiction, and healthy living, either synchronously or asynchronously.

SCHOOL-BASED ADDICTION INTERVENTION PROGRAM

The School-based Addiction Intervention Program (OBM) is Türkiye's first and only school-based intervention program that addresses tobacco, alcohol, substance use, and risky internet use, gaming and gambling behaviors.

The program focuses on supporting students at risk of experimenting with or using addictive substances, as well as those engaging in risky behaviors, helping them remain in the education system while addressing the psychosocial challenges associated with addiction in a sustainable way.

As part of the program, **16,753** psychological counselors have been trained as practitioners.

GREEN CRESCENT LIFE SKILLS TRAINING PROGRAM

The Green Crescent Life Skills Training Program (YYBE) is a school-based prevention program designed to empower students, help them live free from addiction risks, adopt positive habits, and protect themselves from harmful environments and situations.

The program focuses on developing crucial life skills such as problem-solving, stress management, impulse control related to curiosity, and resisting peer pressure, ultimately preventing the risks associated with adolescence.

From 2021 to 2024, the program has reached 121.693 students with the support of 264 psychological counselors across 81 provinces.











HEALTHY GENERATION HEALTHY FUTURE TALENT CONTEST

The Healthy Generation, Healthy Future Talent Contest is held annually across Türkiye in two main categories—literary and visual. Its purpose is to raise awareness of addiction, initiate important conversations around it, and inspire primary, secondary, and high school students to express their creativity and talents.



HIGH SCHOOL DEBATE TOURNAMENT




In partnership with the Ministry of National Education, Green Crescent holds the Green Crescent High School Debate Tournament annually to raise awareness among students about addiction and promote healthy living. The initiative also encourages critical thinking and idea generation on these issues. From 2021 to 2024, the tournament has reached **26,881** students.

GREEN STAGE TALKS



Green Stage connects university students with influential figures from sports, arts, and media, as well as leading experts from various academic fields.

These talks are primarily held at universities.



YOUNG GREEN CRESCENT

The Young Green Crescent team, a leading force in addiction prevention, operates across Türkiye through university clubs established in campuses nationwide.

Throughout the year, they organize various activities including training programs, symposiums, cultural camps, city tours, peer training, cycling tours, and other engaging events.





YOUTH CAMPS



Between 2016 and 2024, over 6,000 Green Crescent Youth members took part in 75 camps. During this time, nearly 90,000 scouts received foundational training on addiction awareness across eight camp locations.



GREEN CRESCENT ADDICTION PREVENTION TRAINING PROGRAMPEER TRAINING

From 2015 to 2024, 1,271 Green Crescent Youth members served as peer training practitioners, reaching 153,026 university students.

GREEN CRESCENT AMBASSADORS

The Green Crescent Ambassadors Project aims to engage local communities and neighborhood businesses in addiction prevention, increasing public awareness and fostering a culture of prevention. Through this initiative, business owners have been trained to enhance their knowledge and create a unified approach on addiction prevention. So far, over 40,395 businesses have been visited, with more than 11,701 business owners becoming Green Crescent Ambassadors.

Launched as a pilot project in 2017, it has been rolled out across Türkiye through Green Crescent branches since 2018.





YOU CAN QUIT MOBILE APPLICATION



The You Can Quit app is designed to guide and offer free support to those looking to quit smoking. Users can download the app to their smartphones to assess their nicotine addiction level, plan their quit journey, and discover effective strategies for managing cravings. The app also provides one-click access to psychological support from Green Crescent Counseling Centers.





GREEN DETECTOR MOBILE APPLICATION



The Green Detector app was created to help enforce smoking bans in indoor spaces, raise awareness about violations, protect the rights of non-smokers, and educate the public on their legal rights. Reports submitted through the app are sent to the Ministry of Health's monitoring system, where inspection teams carry out checks.



FINANCIAL SUPPORT PROGRAMS

These programs aim to increase public awareness in addiction prevention by developing and implementing targeted, thematic, innovative, and sustainable prevention strategies. They also support evidence-based practices focused on rehabilitation and social reintegration processes.

SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH PROJECTS

As part of its scientific efforts, Green Crescent conducts extensive national and regional research using both quantitative and qualitative methods in the field of addiction prevention. These studies help shape relevant policies and intervention programs based on their findings.

Ongoing national research projects include the Wastewater Analysis for Psychoactive Substances Project and the Health Behavior Research Project on the Turkish Population Aged 15 and over.

GRADUATE THESIS RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Green Crescent supports scientific research that contributes to national and international efforts in addiction prevention, advances academic literature, and generate policy and action plans. To nurture the next generation of researchers, it provides scholarships for master's, doctoral, and medical specialization students conducting thesis research on addiction-related topics.








ADDICTA: THE TURKISH JOURNAL ON ADDICTIONS






GREEN CRESCENT BIKE TOUR

MAY 31 TOBACCO DAY

Every year, millions of lives are lost worldwide due to smokingrelated illnesses. On February 9. Quit Smoking Day, nationwide events and awareness campaigns educate the public about the dangers of tobacco use and encourage those who smoke to quit for a healthier future.

On May 31, recognized by the World Health Organization (WHO) as World No Tobacco Day, Green Crescent and its branches host various events across Türkiye.
